

Online course „Video and web 2.0 in your classroom“

Are you interested in the use of video and web2.0 in your classroom? Join our online course for teachers across Europe for five days in May. The course offers concrete ideas about what you can do in your lesson, how you can integrate simple video exercises into your teaching practice and how a practical media approach can help the media competence of your students. The course is also a good resource for those involved in European school projects such as eTwinning or Comenius.

The course will take place on five days in May (the exact five days are not yet finalised). We will 'meet' online on these days for around 2 hours for all tasks and discussions. In between those days you can choose the times when you want to work on the materials. The course content will include ideas about how to structure a video project, how to edit stills and video footage with Movie Maker, how to upload and share and what YouTube offers to improve your video. The course is free of charge but you will need to apply via email. You will receive a certificate after you have finished the full course programme.
